

This responds to your undated letter received in this Office on September 7, 2004, in which you appealed the refusal of the Federal Bureau of Investigation to expedite the processing of your request for records concerning President George W. Bush. I regret the delay in responding.

I am affirming the FBI's denial of your request for expedited treatment under 28 C.F.R. § 16.5(d)(iv)(2004), which allows for expedited treatment of matters of "widespread and exceptional media interest in which there exists possible questions about the government's integrity which effect the public confidence." decision under that standard was made by Mark Carallo, Director of the Office of Public Affairs, in accordance with 28 C.F.R. § 16.5(d)(2). I have determined that Mr. Carallo properly denied your request for expedited processing.

The FBI has already initiated regular processing of your request. You may appeal again to this Office when the FBI completes its action on this particular request if any of the responsive material is denied. We will then open a new appeal and review the component's substantive action on your request.

If you are dissatisfied with my action on your request for expedited treatment of your appeal, you may seek judicial review in accordance with 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)(E)(iii).

The U.S. Secret Service (USSS) is currently conducting an investigation into a presidential threat case involving three (3) packages wrapped with clear packaging tape and one (1) plastic ziplock bag which appears to contain hair and/or fiber-like material in addition to an off-white granular material. DNA, hair, and fiber examinations of the packages have been requested by the USSS Los Angeles field office. We are requesting

assistance from your agency in this matter and would greatly appreciate if these examinations could be performed expeditiously due to the nature of the case.

The following items are included:

One (1) box wrapped with clear tape with an attached letter that begins, "ROSES ARE RED - VIOLETS ARE BLUE - ...," described, in part, as Item 1 on SSF 1544, serial number 127 2003 CE 000361.

Q2 One (1) box wrapped with clear tape with an attached letter that begins, "TO ALL POSTAL EMPLOYEES ...," described, in part, as Item 1 on SSF 1544, serial number 127 2003 CE 000361. The box also contains one (1) white dish towel with two (2) blue stripes.

Q3 One (1) brown paper package wrapped with clear tape addressed: "TO: MS.

..," described, in part, as Item 1 on SSF 1544, serial number 127

K20B One (1) ziplock bag containing white soap residue, described in part as Item 4 on SSF 1544, serial number 127 2003 CE 000362.

It is requested that a DNA analysis be conducted however you deem necessary. A known DNA sample from the suspect will be sent in the near future. Please note, that one (1) cloth dish towel was received with Exhibit Q2 and a DNA examination should be performed on this item as well. An examination for hairs and/or fibers is requested, and pending the results of your findings, additional known samples can be sent at a later date. As well, please compare the hair and/or fiber-like material in the ziplock bag with material recovered from the referenced packages.

The packages have not been processed for latent fingerprints, but this analysis need not be conducted by your laboratory. A preliminary examination has already been


